HISTORY

The Indianola Community Youth Foundation (ICYF) was founded in 2011 with a \$1 million donation from Casey and Abbie Blake. The goal of the foundation was to fund efforts that would benefit the young people of Indianola.

Following a successful "Match The Million" campaign, ICYF donated \$2million toward the completion of the Blake Fieldhouse, adjacent to the Indianola Middle School. This facility, open to everyone, has been a magnet for youth activities including sports, cheer, and dance competitions, music performances, before and after school activities, and much more.

TODAY

ICYF recognizes the importance of good nutrition and healthy eating to kids can perform at their best in everything they do. A nutrition guide was created and made available to all Indianola middle and high school students. Healthy snacks have also been supplied to Indianola High School athletes and musicians when they travel to games and competitions.

TOMORROW

ICYF's vision for the future is to continue with our established programs plus add a new focus on helping kids obtain the items necessary for their success in school and in extracurricular activities. We will work through the schools to identify particular needs of students (who will remain anonymous) and provide what is necessary so they can participate like all other students.

- + More than 4,000 community members of all ages have used more than 750 hours of free open gym in 2014.
- + Open gym is always supervised.
- + ICYF has sponsored the Lace Up for Literacy 5, race with proceeds being donated to area youth organizations.
- + ICYF has sponsored a Halloween Haunted House with proceeds going to area youth organizations.

- + Nutritious snacks have been provided to traveling teams and music organizations.
- + 100% of all dollars donated are reinvested in the Indianola community.
